Cookie Policy

Find out what cookies are and why we use them.

What Are Cookies?

A cookie is a small file, typically of letters and numbers, downloaded on to a device when the user accesses certain websites. Cookies allow a website to recognise a user's device. Cookies are not personally identifiable by themselves, but they can be linked to personal data you provide to us.

Cookies that are used by the FVP Trade are referred to as "First-party Cookies" and those that are used by our partners are "Third-party Cookies". Because of how cookies work, our website cannot access third-party cookies; nor can other organisations access the data in the cookies we use on our website.

What types of cookies do we use?

We use four types of cookies, which we describe in this section.

- **Essential** – cookies that are essential to provide you with services you have requested. For example, these include the cookies that make it possible for you to log in, navigate around and use the features of our Services, or to provide a service requested by you. If you set your browser to block these cookies, then these functions and services will not work for you.
- **Performance** - cookies which measure how often you visit our sites and how you use them. For example, we collect information about which of our pages are most frequently visited, and by which types of users. We also use third-party cookies to help with performance. For example, the Google Analytics cookie gives us information such as your journey between pages and whether you have downloaded anything.
- **Functionality** – cookies that are used to recognise you and remember your preferences or settings when you return to our site, so that we can provide you with a more personalised experience.
- **Advertising** – cookies that are used to collect information about your visit to our site, the content you have viewed, the links you have followed and information about your browser and device. They are used to deliver tailored offers and advertisements to you, based on your derived interests, as well as to perform email marketing campaigns.

How We Use Cookies?

We may use cookies so that we can improve your online experience, including to detect your browser's capabilities, to track ads we display to you, to store login information of your choice, to present advertising and other content on our website that is tailored to your web preferences and usage patterns, and to generate statistics on website usage.

If you do not accept these cookies to be used or set your browser settings such that it does not accept FVP Trade cookies, then you may not be able to access or use some of the website functionalities, nor will we be able to provide you with our services.

How Third Parties Use Cookies?

Our website may allow third parties to download cookies onto your device. Third parties, such as analytics firms and business partners (including Google) may use cookies and other technologies (including Google Analytics) to collect information about your online activities while you are on our website. This information may be used to measure usage of our website and personalise advertising content on our website. We do not have access to or control over cookies or other features these third parties may use, and the information practices of these third parties are not covered by this Cookie Policy. Please refer to the privacy and cookie policies of those third parties to better understand their activities and practices.

Google Analytics

We use features of Google Analytics in accordance with the How We Use Cookies section. For more details on how Google Analytics functions, please refer to Google's Privacy Policy. According to its own policy, Google does not collect any personal data using Google Analytics. Nevertheless, if you do not want to use the remarketing feature from Google, you can disable it by changing the appropriate settings at [Google Ad Settings](#)

Cookies used by our websites:

- **Do not** store any personally identifiable information such as passwords
- **Do not** access any other information stored on your computer
- **Do not** compromise the security of your device(s)
- **Do** allow us to provide a service through which people can access their trading account(s)
- **Do** allow us to monitor the number of people using our website
- **Do** allow us to see how people arrive at our website (for example, via search engine or via email)
- **Do** allow us to gather technical information about people using our website, such as their geographical location and the type of web browsers they are using
- **Do** allow us to display advertisements on other websites to people who have previously accessed our websites (for example, banner ads). We can't identify individuals to whom these advertisements may be displayed.
- **Do** allow us to display content on our websites that is more relevant to you and your preferences based on the information we hold and your behaviour on our website
- **Do** allow our website to recall certain settings and preferences to make it easier to use our website.

How to Manage Your Cookie Settings?

There are various ways in which you can manage and control your cookie settings. Please remember that, by deleting or blocking cookies, some of the features of the Services may not work properly or as effectively.

- Most web browsers will provide you with some general information about cookies, enable you to see what cookies are stored on your device, allow you to delete them all or on an individual basis, and enable you to block or allow cookies for all websites or

individually selected websites. You can also normally turn off third-party cookies separately. Please note that the settings offered by a browser or device often only apply to that particular browser or device.
